

PowerPoint Animation

Assignment:

Use Paint.NET and Microsoft PowerPoint to create an animation. You do this by making a series of slides that are slightly different from each other and running the slideshow quickly. This is similar to the hand-drawn flip book animations you may have made before.

- 1) Tell a simple story with your animation.
- 2) Use at least 80 slides (It will be better if you use more). It will look smoother if you do not make big changes from slide to slide.
- 3) Create your first picture in Paint.NET and then select, copy, and paste it onto the first slide in PowerPoint.
- 4) Create your “static background” on the first layer of Paint.NET and make each moving object on it’s own layer.
- 5) Copy/paste the background to your first slide and resize it to fit.
- 6) Copy/paste each object onto your powerpoint slide.
- 7) [Ctrl-D] will duplicate the slide – then you can move your objects slightly.
